Since 2021, the Bernapark Museum – Kunstraum Thomas Demarmels has been inviting visitors to immerse themselves in the fascinating world of contemporary painting and creative art. The museum is located directly on the Bernapark site in Deisswil, Switzerland and is an integral part of its vibrant ecosystem.

The focus is on the work of Bernese graphic artist, scientific illustrator, and long-time teacher at the Bern School of Design, Thomas Demarmels, whose hyperrealistic, color-intensive, and powerful works impressively combine the themes of humanity, nature, and spirituality.

The museum offers individual visits, exciting films about the artist's life and work, informative documentation, and group tours. Exclusive tours with the artist himself can also be booked on request. The small museum shop sells art prints, cards, and selected art supplies from Caran d'Ache.

In addition to the impressive permanent exhibition by Thomas Demarmels, the spacious gallery presents changing exhibitions by other selected regional, national, and international artists – a place of inspiration and encounter.
